Parking Permits

Parking a vehicle at Pebble Shores for longer than a few days requires a parking permit. These may be obtained by owners, residents, and guests at the Clubhouse on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 – 7:00 p.m. Parking permits will not be issued for trucks.

Use of Dumpsters/Recycling

Dumpsters are not to be used to dispose of large items or furniture. These items may not be left in the dumpster area or placed in the dumpster. Trash to be recycled should be placed in the green containers loose, not in bags.

Decorating Guidelines

Our rules prohibit residents from displaying decorations whether for personal celebrations, religious or civil holidays. All window treatments must be white or off-white in color. Nothing should be draped over the railings. No "For Sale" or any other signage should be displayed.

Smoking Rule

3.16a Smoking of cigarettes and other tobacco products is prohibited in the unit lanais or other Limited Common Elements or Common Elements where it presents a nuisance or annoyance to others. (Effective March 1, 2016)

Fishing in the Lake

Fishing in the lake from shore is permitted. However, please do not leave fishing gear along the bank. Only catch and release fishing is permitted. No boats or watercraft are allowed. No swimming in the lake.

Showering in Pool

All swimmers must rinse off under the pool shower before entering the pool or spa. Showering with soap and shampooing hair are not allowed in the pool area. This causes the floor to become slippery and dangerous, and for residue to get into the pool water.

Postings on Bulletin Boards

Owners may neatly post information on the mailbox bulletin boards. All postings should have contact information and be dated.
