

Recycling Questions

When is my recycling collection day? Your recycling collection day is the same day as your yard waste collection day. To verify your collection day, call customer service at **(239) 252-2380**.

How do I load my cart?

To place recyclables in your yellow-top recycling cart, always lift the lid from the front. **Do not bag recyclables.** Do not place food waste, yard waste or hazardous waste such as paint, oil, fluorescent bulbs or batteries or medical waste in your cart. Do not overload.



What does it mean when a notice sticker is placed on my recycling cart?

The stickers are informational. Read the sticker to understand why your cart was not emptied. Remove any non-recyclable materials or other contaminants indicated on the sticker and place the cart curbside on your next collection day. If you have questions after reading the information on the sticker, call customer service at **(239) 252-2380**.

What should I do if my recycling is not picked up on my regular collection day, or if my cart is broken? If you have concerns or questions about your recycling service call customer service at **(239) 252-2380**.

Can I get a second recycling cart? How much will it cost? If you need a second recycling cart, please call customer service at **(239) 252-2380**. A second recycling cart is provided free by the county. Excess recycling may be taken to a recycling drop-off center for free.

If I move out of my home, what do I do with the trash and recycling carts? The trash and recycling carts are assigned to the home, not to the homeowner. If you move, please leave the trash and recycling carts.

1-2-3 Recycle

1. Remove all food waste. **2.** Put recyclables loose in your yellow-top recycling cart. Do not bag. **3.** On your recycling collection day, place your yellow-top recycling cart at the curb with three feet of clearance from other objects. Residents in multi-family properties should contact their property manager for recycling instructions.

Classroom and office paper, unwanted mail, catalogs, magazines and phone books



Paper Bags

Cardboard and packaging boxes—clean and dry (Flatten or cut to no larger than 3' x 3')



Plastic bottles and jars through through



Check with your local grocery store for plastic bag recycling options.

Egg cartons and food trays



Milk cartons and juice containers



Aluminum, steel, and tin food and beverage cans
